ANSI/ISEA 107-2010 COMPLIANT SAFETY GARMENTS ARE CLASSIFIED AS FOLLOWS



Class 2 Garments - intended for use in activities where greater visibility is necessary during inclement weather conditions or in work environments with risks that exceed those for Class 1. Garments in this class also cover workers who perform tasks that divert their attention from approaching traffic, or that put them in close proximity to passing vehicles traveling at 25 mph or greater.

- Forestry Operations
- Delivery Vehicle Drivers
- Roadway Construction
- Utility & Railway Workers
- School Crossing Guards
- Ship Cargo Loading Operation
- High Volume Parking & Toll Gate Personnel
- Airport Baggage & Handlers / Ground Crew
- Emergency Response & Law Enforcement
- Trash Collection & Recycling Operations



Class 3 Garments - provide the highest level of visibility, and are intended for workers who face serious hazards, such as nighttime work, and often have task loads that require attention away from approaching vehicle traffic. Garments for these workers should provide enhanced visibility to more of the body, such as arms and legs.

- Emergency Response Personnel
